## Mayor's Corner

Spring is here! It is great to see people out walking in the neighborhoods and working in their yards. This is always a motivating time of year for people to do some spring cleaning and to take on some new projects around their homes. It is great to see people making the effort and improving their properties. Some projects, even though they are small may require a permit. Large landscaping projects, new siding for your house and even a new tool shed may require a permit. Please take a minute and call city hall to discuss your project. Our city staff is always available to help you determine if your project requires any permits. It is much easier to deal with this before the project starts than to deal with it later. We are here to help, so please call with questions.

The City recently completed a resident survey with the help of Matt Kline. A significant number of residents expressed concern about “junk and debris” in our city. Enough concern was raised that the City Council will review our ordinances and develop a plan for code enforcement. It would be better if everyone with this problem in their yards took advantage of the upcoming spring clean up event. It would be much better and a more proactive approach to this problem. If you have debris in your yard, old cars, deteriorated structures etcetera, now would be a great time to contact City Hall for information on what items can be disposed of at the Spring Clean Up.

The annual Spring Cleanup is scheduled for May 2nd. This year we will also be accepting electronic items to be recycled in addition to the items we have accepted in the past.

The City will also be doing its share of clean up work this spring and summer. Work will continue in our parks and landscaping will be completed along County Road 18 this summer and fall.

### ***Highlights of Planning Commission (PC) Meeting***

A public hearing was held on an application by David Erickson for a Conditional Use Permit for operation of Village Wine & Spirits at 365 St. Croix Trail South in Lakeland Village, with recommendation to forward the application to the City Council for approval as submitted.

Discussion was held regarding the new Thrift Shop in Lakeland Village.

### ***Highlights of Special City Council (CC) Meeting***

Motion was made to advise the Washington County Sheriff's Office to proceed with the grant application for COPS Hiring Recovery Program on behalf of the City of Lakeland, understanding the other cities of the Joint Powers Agreement must also approve/agree.

A work session was held regarding the 2009-2010 Budget.

- Cable Commission is in process of reviewing the Franchise Agreement
- Yellow Ribbon is progressing.
- Establishment of improved communications between communities regarding legislative matters that affect the communities.

## ***For Your Information***

### ***Parking Permits Have Expired***

The area of the City between I-94 and Upper 5th Street North, and CSAH 18 and the St. Croix River, is a designated parking area where permits are required for street parking. Annual permits cost \$1 each, and five permits are allowed for each residence. Event permits are available for single-day parking and cost \$5. Permits may be obtained at City Hall.

### ***Park Hours***

All public parks and picnic areas (not owned in the name of the State of Minnesota) shall be open for the use of the general public between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

During the months of September through May, curfew for minors is between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. During the curfew period, it is unlawful for any minor under the age of 16 to idle, loiter, or be upon the public streets, boulevards, sidewalks, alleys, parks, beach, or any other public place in the City of Lakeland.

### ***Golfers Swing Into Spring***

Flying golf balls can prove dangerous to other park users and to homes adjacent to the parks. In addition, stray balls cause damage and costly repairs to mowing equipment. Please remember that hitting golf balls in the City's parks is not allowed!

## Public Safety

### A Reminder

If you see any unusual or suspicious activity, it is important to call the Sheriff's Department directly at (651) 439-9381 so a deputy can respond immediately.

### DNR-Imposed Burning Ban in Effect

Effective immediately through mid-May, a burning ban is in effect. Penalties double during a burning ban. Recreational fires are allowed; but please review the regulations below:

- A recreational fire is permitted without a burn permit.
- Fire should be no larger than 3 feet across and 3 feet high.
- Logs must be 3 inches in diameter or larger.
- Fire must be constantly attended until the fire is completely extinguished.
- A connected garden hose or other means of extinguishing the fire quickly must be readily available.

Since recreational fires can be considered a public nuisance, care and consideration should be taken when placing your recreational fire in a position that may offend your neighbors. If you have an issue with a neighbor burning, please call Washington County non-emergency at (651) 439-9381 and your call will be reported to the local on-duty fire officer.

### Tornado Tips

With the tornado season approaching, a few safety tips are provided. If you see a dark or greenish sky, large hail, or a loud roar (similar to the sound of a train), or you are advised that a tornado warning has been issued, follow these tips:

- In a home or other building, move to a predestinated shelter, such as a basement.
- If an underground shelter is not available, move to an interior room or hallway on the lowest floor and get under a sturdy piece of furniture.
- Stay away from windows.
- Get out of automobiles.
- Do not try to outrun a tornado in your car; instead, leave the car immediately.
- A mobile home, even if tied down, offers little protection from tornados; abandon it immediately.

Occasionally, tornados develop so rapidly that advance warning is not possible. Remain alert for signs of an approaching tornado. Flying debris from high winds causes most of the deaths and injuries associated with tornados.

### Watch for Children

There is a 30 mile per hour speed limit on all City streets, unless otherwise posted. With school in session and road construction in process, special care should be taken to watch for children on bikes and people walking. Drive **slowly** through neighborhoods, and please observe the stop signs at designated intersections.

## ***Pet Owners***

## ***All Animals Must Be Leashed***

The Animal Control Officer can pick up dogs and cats running at large. If the animal is licensed, every effort will be made to return the animal to its owner. If the animal is unlicensed, it will be taken to the St. Croix Animal Shelter and held until the owner has paid all City and shelter fees.

## **Fire Hydrant Flushing**

The Lakeland Water Department will begin to flush hydrants this month. Flushing is done every six months to remove deposits that build up in the water lines over the winter. Fire hydrants are inspected and maintained at the same time. Flushing creates a disturbance in the water mains, sometimes causing water discoloration. Anyone experiencing water discoloration lasting longer than a day should call the Water Department at 436-8044.
